

LGBT2SQ+ WALL OF FAME

PURPOSE

This is an activity and an outcome that builds the visibility of well-known people who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, trans, Two-Spirit, queer, questioning, and intersex. Developing a Wall of Fame in one's workplace is a concrete step toward increasing queer-friendly workplace culture, as well as communicating to people coming into the workplace that this environment recognizes and celebrates the rainbow community.

INSTRUCTIONS

Place a suggestion box in the reception area with a sign inviting anyone coming in to deposit the name of a public personage who is out as lesbian, gay, bisexual, trans, Two-Spirit, queer, questioning, or intersex.

Choose a location in the workplace that is a central gathering place and easily viewable. The front entryway is preferred, because it is a well-established location for invitation and welcome. Find current, clear, and high-quality images of the people identified and erect a permanent, expandable display. This could be a material, tangible testament of printed photographs, or a digital version with a rotating slideshow of images.
